## 會長報告

首先祝各位身體健康，萬事如意。在這個充滿挑戰和變化的一年裡，我們的學會已經踏入第 35 屆，並且在園藝推廣活動方面取得了不少成績。我們的學會的宗旨是推動園藝教育和文化，提高公眾對園藝的興趣和認識，以及促進園藝愛好者之間的交流和合作。在這裡，我要向各位報告過去一年的主要活動和成就，以及未來的計劃和展望。

今年的香港花卉展覽於三月在維多利亞公園恢復舉行，學會一如既往支持及參加，並以{幸福廚房花園-香草植物篇}為主題展示了一個室內園景設計，展示了不同種類的蔬菜和香草植物在家中草坪或以用器種植，可以食用也增加在家種植興趣。我們的園景設計獲得了最佳設計大獎，這是對我們的努力和創意的肯定。我要感謝參與設計和製作園景的會員和義工，以及所有到場支持和欣賞我們園景的會員。此外，我也要感謝我們的名譽會長鄧永昌先生，在香港花卉展覽期間，主持了一場關於國蘭的精彩講座，向大家分享了他對國蘭栽培和保育的豐富經驗和心得。

學會與寶蓮禪寺及星島日報在六月份聯合在大嶼山昂坪寶蓮禪寺舉辦了 2023 荷花展覽。這是一次集展覽、教育、文化、慈善於一體的活動，旨在讓公眾欣賞荷花之美，並了解荷花在佛教文化中的意義和價值。學會主要在種植荷花及擺放荷花方面擔任顧問工作，並提供了多種品種和顏色的分類。我要感謝所有參與種植和擺放荷花的會員和義工。同時，也要感謝名譽會員袁轉好女士為荷花展覽主持了一場荷花插花示範講座及工作坊，向大家介紹了如何利用荷花製作美麗和富有創意的插花作品。另外，也要感謝名譽會員黃源喜先生為荷花展覽開幕典禮提供了所有主禮嘉賓的襟花和手花，為活動增添了一份高雅和氣派。最後，感謝丹青閣書畫苑應



學會邀請展出荷花書畫和攝影展覽，展示了他們用筆墨和鏡頭捕捉荷花之美的作品。這次展覽非常成功，並獲得了廣泛的媒體報導和社會讚譽。

會學也為會員安排了一些園藝活動，讓會員有機會學習和交流園藝知識和技巧，以及欣賞不同的園藝景觀和植物。這些活動包括參觀香港花卉展覽，觀賞各種精美的園景設計和花卉展品，並與其他園藝團體交流心得；參與大嶼山寶蓮禪寺種植荷花的義工活動，親自體驗荷花的栽培過程，並學習如何護理和繁殖荷花；參觀 2023 荷花展覽，欣賞不同品種和顏色的荷花，並參加荷花插花、書畫和攝影等相關活動。

為加強兩地園藝交流，與深圳花卉協會舉行交流會，分享彼此的園藝經驗和成果，並參觀深圳市內的一些優秀的園藝景點。此外，我們的會員也恆常每日在會址進行種植及交流栽種知識；在會址種植了多種不同的植物，包括農作物、花卉、多肉植物、盆栽植物、香草植物等。會學也定期舉辦一些小型的園藝教學和示範活動，讓會員可以互相學習和分享。

雖然我們在園藝推廣活動方面取得了不少成就，但是我們在會址方面卻遇到了一些困難。由於地政總署以政策為由，未能給予學會租地的租用期，故此香港賽馬會慈善基金未能將我們的維修費用申請上呈。這導致我們無法對會址進行必要的改善和修理工程，影響了我們的正常運作和發展。我們已經向有關部門反映了我們的困境，並希望能盡快得到解決。我們也會尋求其他的解決方案希望能盡快恢復我們的會址的功能和美觀，為我們的會員提供一個更好的園藝環境和氛圍。

最後，我要再次感謝本會名譽顧問、名譽會長、名譽律師、名譽會計師、名譽會員及全體理事會成員及會員的支持和參與。沒有你們的貢獻和努力，我們的學會就不可能有今天的成就和發展。你們的鼓勵和肯定是我們前進的動力和信心。在未來的一年裡，我們將繼續努力，推動園藝事業的發展，為社會創造更多的美好和價值。我也期待與各位保持緊密的聯繫和合作，共同享受園藝帶來的樂趣和收穫。

# 第三十五屆週年會員

## 大會會議記錄

香港園藝學會第三十五屆周年會員大會於二零二二年十一月二十二日下午六時三十分假沙田鄉大涌橋路五十五號 Club One 水中天舉行。參與會議之基本會員 27 人，另外有 32 名基本會員簽署了委託書授權其他基本會員參與會議，共 59 名基本會員出席，合符公司組織大綱第二十節所需之法定人數(即 58 名基本會員及院士)。以下是大會之討論事項及議案：

### (甲)會務

會長徐荷芬女士, *MIHort(HK)* 滙報過去一年舉辦的活動和其他重要事項。今年一月，學會探訪了大嶼山昂平寶蓮禪寺，除園藝交流外，並商討合作於寶蓮寺舉辦「2023 荷花展」。同時，學會在八月舉辦了參觀 Y Park 活動，學習及參與如何將廢棄的綠化木質轉作環保用途。此外，學會亦重新開放了會所的部分園圃，供作種植訓練活動之用。學會會繼續向香港賽馬會申請資金來翻新我們的會所。

學會今年亦繼續與其他團體機構合作園藝推廣，派出導師向志願或慈善團體免費提供園藝指導或講座服務。活動包括與綠在灣仔合作舉辦網上園藝講座及為漁護署香港濕地公園舉辦園藝課程，透過這些活動積



極推廣園藝工作。會長多謝所有名譽會長、名譽會員、理事及會員過去一年的努力。與會會員授權理事會繼續按本會宗旨，策劃及推行會務。

## (乙)財務報告及審核

**意見**

本核數師(以下簡稱「我們」)已審核列載於第五至十三頁香港園藝學會(以下簡稱「貴學會」)的財務報表，此財務報表包括於二〇二三年三月三十一日的財務狀況表與截至該日止年度的收益表及會員權益變動表，以及財務報表附註，包括主要會計政策概要。

我們認為，該等財務報表在所有重大方面已根據香港會計師公會頒布的中小企財務報告準則擬備，並已遵照香港公司條例妥為擬備。

**意見的基礎**

我們已根據香港會計師公會頒布的香港審計準則，並參考實務說明900項(經修訂)「審計根據中小企財務報告準則編制的財務報表」進行審計。我們在該等準則下承擔的責任已在本報告「核數師就審計財務報表承擔的責任」部分中作進一步闡述。根據香港會計師公會頒布的专业會計師道德守則(以下簡稱「守則」)，我們獨立於貴學會，並已覆行守則中的其他專業道德責任。我們相信，我們所獲得的審計憑證能充足及適當地為我們的審計保留意見提供基礎。

**財務報表及其他核數師報告以外的信息**

理事需對其他信息負責，其他信息包括刊載於香港園藝學會二〇二三年年報內的信息，但不包括財務報表及我們的核數師報告。

我們對財務報表的意見並不涵蓋其他信息，我們亦不對該等其他信息發表任何形式的鑒證結論。

結合我們對財務報表的審計，我們的責任是閱讀其他信息，在此過程中，考慮其他信息是否與財務報表或我們在審計過程中所了解的情況存在重大抵觸或者似乎存在重大錯誤陳述的情況。

基於我們已執行的工作，如果我們認為其他信息存在重大錯誤陳述，我們需要報告該事實。在這方面，我們沒有任何報告。

**理事就財務報表須承擔的責任**

理事須負責根據香港會計師公會頒布的香港中小企財務報告準則及香港公司條例擬備財務報表，並對其認為為使財務報表的擬備不存在由於欺詐或錯誤而導致的重大錯誤陳述所需的內部控制負責。

在擬備財務報表時，理事負責評估貴學會持續經營的能力，並在適用情況下披露與持續經營有關的事項，以及使用持續經營為會計基礎，除非理事有意將貴學會清盤或停止經營，或別無其他實際的替代方案。

**核數師就審計財務報表承擔的責任**

我們的目標，是對財務報表整體是否不存在由於欺詐或錯誤而導致的重大錯誤陳述取得合理保證，並出具包括我們意見的核數師報告，並根據香港公司條例第405條，僅向學會全體會員報告而並無其他目的。

合理保證是高水平的保證，但不能保證按照香港審計準則進行的審計，在某一重大錯誤陳述存在時總能發現。錯誤陳述可以由欺詐或錯誤引起，如果合理預期它們單獨或滙總起來可能影響財務報表使用者依賴財務報表所作出的經濟決定，則有關的錯誤陳述可被視作重大。

在根據香港審計準則進行審計的過程中，我們運用了專業判斷，保持了專業懷疑態度。我們亦：

- 識別和評估由於欺詐或錯誤而導致財務報表存在重大錯誤陳述的風險，設計及執行審計程序以應對這些風險，以及獲取充足和適當的審計憑證，作為我們意見的基礎。由於欺詐可能涉及串謀、偽造、蓄意遺漏、虛假陳述，或凌駕於內部控制之上，因此未能發現因欺詐而導致的重大錯誤陳述的風險高於未能發現因錯誤而導致的重大錯誤陳述的風險。
- 了解與審計相關的內部控制，以設計適當的審計程序，但目的並非對貴學會內部控制的有效性發表意見。
- 評價理事所採用會計政策的恰當性及作出會計估計和相關披露的合理性。

- 對理事採用持續經營會計基礎的恰當性作出結論。根據所獲取的審計憑證，確定是否存在與事項或情況有關的重大不確定性，從而可能導致對貴學會的持續經營能力產生重大疑慮。如果我們認為存在重大不確定性，則有必要在核數師報告中提請使用者注意財務報表中的相關披露。假若有關的披露不足，則我們應當發表非無保留意見。我們的結論是基於核數師報告日止所取得的審計憑證。然而，未來事項或情況可能導致貴學會不能持續經營。

除其他事項外，我們與理事溝通了計劃的審計範圍、時間安排、重大審計發現等，包括我們在審計中識別出內部控制的任何重大缺陷。

**(1) 學會背景資料**

本學會是根據香港公司法例於一九九七年四月十六日註冊成立之無股本的擔保有限公司。本學會成立的目的是推廣園藝學。而本會之日常運作由理事會成員負責。本學會註冊地址為香港新界大埔汀角路 65 號。

於二〇〇二年七月十五日，本學會根據前公司法例第二十一條成功向公司註冊處處長申請免除顯示有限公司於本會中英文名稱上。另外，本學會於二〇〇二年八月二十二日舉行之會員特別大會上通過將本會之英文名稱由 Society of Horticulture (Hong Kong) 改為 Institute of Horticulture (Hong Kong)。

根據本學會成立之組織章程，會員於本學會結束時如仍為本學會會員或結束一年內之會員須為本學會清還負債，惟總額不能超過每名會員港幣 500.00。

**(2) 遵例聲明**

根據《香港公司條例》(第 622 章)第 359(1)(a)條，本學會符合小型擔保公司的資格在提供財務報告方面獲豁免。因此本學會根據香港會計師公會頒佈的《中小企財務報告準則》編製本財務報表。

本財務報表乃按照香港會計師公會頒佈的《中小型企業財務報告準則》，並以應計概念及持續經營基準而編製。

**(3) 編製基準**

本財務報表包括收益表、財務狀況表、會員權益變動表及會計政策及財務報表附註解釋。

本公司以港幣記賬及本財務報表乃以歷史成本作編製並同以港幣呈報。

(4) 主要會計政策

(a) 資本性支出

本學會資本性支出按成本減折舊及慈善團體之有關資助列賬。

折舊乃按資本性支出減有關慈善團體之資助款後按估計可用年期以直線法攤銷，所用年率如下：

修建會址	:	10%
裝修、傢俬及設備	:	20%

(b) 應收賬款

應收賬款以每單一賬款可變現值計值。當賬款估計無法全部收回時，需作出合適撥備，並在收益表內確認。

(c) 待售書冊

待售書冊以成本值及可變現淨值兩者中較低者列賬，成本按先進先出法計算，可變現淨值根據預計銷售所得款項減去估計銷售開支釐定。

(d) 所得稅

所得稅開支指當期應繳所得稅，當期應繳所得稅乃根據當年應課稅溢利按結算日已生效或實際有效的稅率計算。

不需提撥遞延稅。

(e) 收入確認

收入之確認基準是當本學會可以可靠地計量及能夠獲得經濟利益時並按以下基準確認為收入：

- (i) 贊助、捐款、會員入會費及年費收入僅在收到時或學會已有權收取時方予入賬。
- (ii) 活動之收入於活動完成時確認入賬。
- (iii) 出售書冊以收款或書冊分銷商通知日期，以較早者確認入賬。

(4) 主要會計政策 – 續

(f) 資產減值

於每一個報告年度，本學會評估資產有否出現資產減值或回撥的跡象，資產包括物業、廠房及設備、無形資產及長期投資。倘資產之賬面值超過可回收額，則賬面值削減至可回收額，並在收益表內確認。回撥往年度之資產減值，只有在採用資產減值之估計出現改變時才會回撥。但計算可回撥數額時，此數不能多於在沒有減值的情況下有關資產折舊或攤銷後之賬面值。

(g) 撥備及或然負債

倘本學會需就過去事項承擔現有法律或推定責任，而可能導致資源流出以履行該責任，如能夠可靠地估計金額，就需要提撥準備。

倘若經濟資源流出可能不會發生或不能夠可靠地衡量應付負債之金額，除非經濟資源流出之機會極低，該債務只需於財務報表附註披露為或然負債。可能發生債務其最終會否形成是取決於日後一項或多項會或不會發生之事項，除非發生機會極低，該債務也只需於財務報表披露為或然負債。

## *The President's Report*

First of all, I wish you all good health and all the best. In this challenging and changing year, our Institute has achieved a lot in promoting horticulture activities. The mission of our Institute is to promote horticulture education and culture, raise public interest and awareness of horticulture and facilitate communication and cooperation among horticulture enthusiasts. Here, I would like to report to you the main activities and achievements of the past year, as well as the plans and prospects for the future.

This year's Hong Kong Flower Show was resumed in March at Victoria Park. Our Institute supported and participated as usual, and displayed an indoor garden design with the theme "Joys of a Kitchen Garden: Culinary Herbs", advocating home cultivation of vegetables and herbs in lawns and planters for self consumption. Our display won the "Grand Award for Design Excellence", which is a recognition of our efforts and creativity. I would like to thank our Honorary President Mr. Tang Wing Cheong, who hosted a wonderful lecture on Chinese Orchids during the Hong Kong Flower Show, and shared his rich experience and insights on orchid cultivation and conservation.

The Institute co-organized the 2023 Lotus Exhibition with Po Lin Monastery and Sing Tao Daily at Po Lin Monastery on Lantau Island in June. This was an event that combined exhibition, education, culture, and charity, aiming to let the public appreciate the beauty of lotus flowers and understand their significance and value in Buddhist culture. Our Institute mainly acted as consultancy in providing technical advises on planting and arranging lotus display, as well as assisting in classification of various varieties of lotus and water lilies species. I would like to thank all the members and volunteers who participated in planting and arranging lotus display. At the same time, I would like

to thank Honorary Member Ms. Tonie Yuen for hosting a lotus flower arrangement demonstration and workshop for the lotus show, introducing how to use lotus flowers to make beautiful and creative flower arrangements. My thanks also go to Honorary Member Mr. James Wong for providing corsages and hand flowers for all the guests of honor at the opening ceremony of the lotus exhibition, adding a touch of elegance and style to the event. Finally, I would also like to thank our invited guest, Dan Ching Kok Gallery for their lotus painting and photography exhibition, showing their works that capture the beauty of lotus flowers with brush and lens. This exhibition was very successful and received extensive media coverage and social acclaim.

The Institute also arranged some horticulture activities for our members, allowing them to learn and exchange horticulture knowledge and skills, as well as appreciate different gardening landscapes and plants. These activities include: visiting the Hong Kong Flower Show, admiring various exquisite garden designs and floral exhibits, and exchanging experiences with other gardening groups; participating in the volunteer activity of planting lotus flowers at Po Lin Monastery on Lantau Island, experiencing the cultivation process of lotus flowers personally, and learning how to care for and propagate lotus flowers; visiting the 2023 Lotus Exhibition, appreciating different varieties and colors of lotus flowers, and participating in related activities such as lotus flower arrangement, painting, and photography.

To strengthen cross-border horticulture exchange, the Institute held an exchange meeting with Shenzhen Flower Association, sharing each other's horticulture experiences and achievements, and visiting some excellent gardening attractions in Shenzhen.

Although we have achieved a lot in promoting gardening activities, we have encountered some difficulties in terms of our premises. Due to policy reasons, the Lands Department could not give us a lease term for renting land. As a result, the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust could not submit our funding application for renovation. Without funding support, we are hardly carrying out necessary improvement and repair works on our premises, affecting our normal operation and development. We have reflected our plight to the relevant departments and hope to get it resolved as soon as possible. We will also seek other solutions to hope to restore the function and appearance of our premises,

providing a better horticulture practicing environment and atmosphere for our members.

Finally, I would like to thank our Honorary Advisor, Honorary Presidents, Honorary Legal Adviser, Honorary Auditor, Honorary Members Executive Committee members and all members of our Institute for their support and participation. Without your contribution and effort, our Institute would not have today's achievements and development. Your encouragement and affirmation are our motivation and confidence to move forward. In the coming year, we will continue to work hard to promote the development of horticulture, creating more beauty and value for society. I also look forward to have your unfailing support, and enjoying the fun and harvest that horticulture brings. # *Minutes of the 35<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting*

The 35<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of the Institute was held on 22 November 2022 at 6:30 p.m. at Riviera, Club One, 55-57 Tai Chung Kiu Road, Sha Tin. 27 Full Members presented and 32 Full Members attended by proxy. A total of 59 Full Members attended the meeting. According to paragraph 20 of the “Articles of Association”, a quorum requiring the attendance of at least 58 Full Members or Fellows was found. The following motions were carried with the approval of all Members present.

## **(A) Work of the Institute**

The President, Ms Florence TSUI, *MIHort(HK)* presented a summary of the activities and major issues organized or undertaken during the past 12 months. In January 2022, we conducted a visit to Po Lin Monastery to consider a jointly organised “Hong Kong Lotus Show 2023” in Po Lin Monastery. Another visit to Y Park was organised in August 2022, where we have a better understanding and see their effort of turning waste green wooden materials to new life. **(1) Reporting entity**

The Institute was incorporated on 16 April, 1997 under the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance as a company with limited liability by guarantee not having a share capital. The objective for which the Institute was established is to promote the study of horticulture. The operations of the Institute are controlled by the Council Members. The address of its registered office is 65 Ting Kok Road, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong.

On 15 July, 2002, the Institute successfully under section 21 of the predecessor Companies Ordinance obtained the consent from the Registrar of the Companies Registry to dispense with Limited in its name. Also by a special resolution passed at extraordinary general meeting on 22 August, 2002, the Institute's name was changed from Society of Horticulture (Hong Kong) to Institute of Horticulture (Hong Kong).

Under the provision of the Institute's Memorandum and Articles of Association, every Member of the Institute undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Institute in the event of the Institute being wound-up during the time when he is a Member, or within one year afterwards, to meet the liabilities of the Institute but not exceeding the sum of HK\$500 each.

**(2) Statement of compliance**

The Institute qualifies for the reporting exemption as a small guarantee company under section 359(1)(a) of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance (Cap. 622). The company is a small guarantee company and is therefore entitled to prepare and present its financial statements in accordance with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard ("SME-FRS") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

These financial statements comply with the SME-FRS and have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the Institute is a going concern.

**(3) Basis of preparation**

These financial statements include income statement, statement of financial position, statement of changes in members' equity and related notes.

The measurement basis used in preparing these financial statements is historical cost. The reporting currency and the presentation currency are Hong Kong dollars.

**(4) Principal accounting policies**

**(a) Capital expenditures**

The Institute states the capital expenditures at cost less accumulated depreciation and the related subsidies from charitable organization.

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost of capital expenditures less the related subsidies from charitable organization over their estimated useful lives on a straight-line basis at the following rates per annum:-

Club house refurbishment	: 10%
Furniture, fixtures and equipment	: 20%

**(b) Account and other receivables**

Trade and other receivables are stated at estimated realisable value after each debt has been considered individually. Where the payment of a debt becomes doubtful a provision is made and charged to the income statement.

**(c) Books for sale**

Books for sale are stated at the lower of cost of purchase and net realisable value. Cost is valued by the method of first-in first-out basis. Net realisable value is based on estimated selling prices less any estimated costs to be incurred to disposal.

**(d) Income tax**

Income tax expense represents current tax expense. The income tax payable represents the amounts expected to be paid to the taxation authority, using the tax rates (and tax laws) that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the end of the reporting period.

Deferred tax is not provided.

**(4) Principal accounting policies – cont'd**

**(e) Recognition of income**

Revenue is recognised when it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Institute and when the revenue can be measured reliably, on the following bases:-

- (i) Sponsorship, donations, membership entry fee and annual subscription, is recognised when it is received or becomes receivable.
- (ii) Income from event is recognised when the event takes place and finishes.
- (iii) Sales of books are recognised when sales proceeds is received by the Institute or notified by the distribution agents whichever is earlier.

**(f) Impairment of assets**

An assessment is made at the end of each reporting period to determine whether there is any indication of impairment or reversal of previous impairment, including items of property, plant and equipment, intangible assets and long-term investments. In the event that an asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount, the carrying amount is reduced to recoverable amount and an impairment loss is recognised in the income statement. A previously recognised impairment loss is reversed only if there has been a change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount, however not to an amount higher than the carrying amount that would have been determined (net of amortisation or depreciation), had no impairment losses been recognised for the asset in prior reporting periods.

**(g) Provisions and contingent liabilities**

Provisions are recognised for liabilities of uncertain timing or amount when the Institute has a legal or constructive obligation arising as a result of a past event and it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made.

Where it is not probable that an outflow of economic benefits will be required, or the amount cannot be estimated reliably, the obligation is disclosed as a contingent liability, unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote. Possible obligations, whose existence will only be confirmed by the occurrence or nonoccurrence of one or more future events are also disclosed as contingent liabilities unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote.

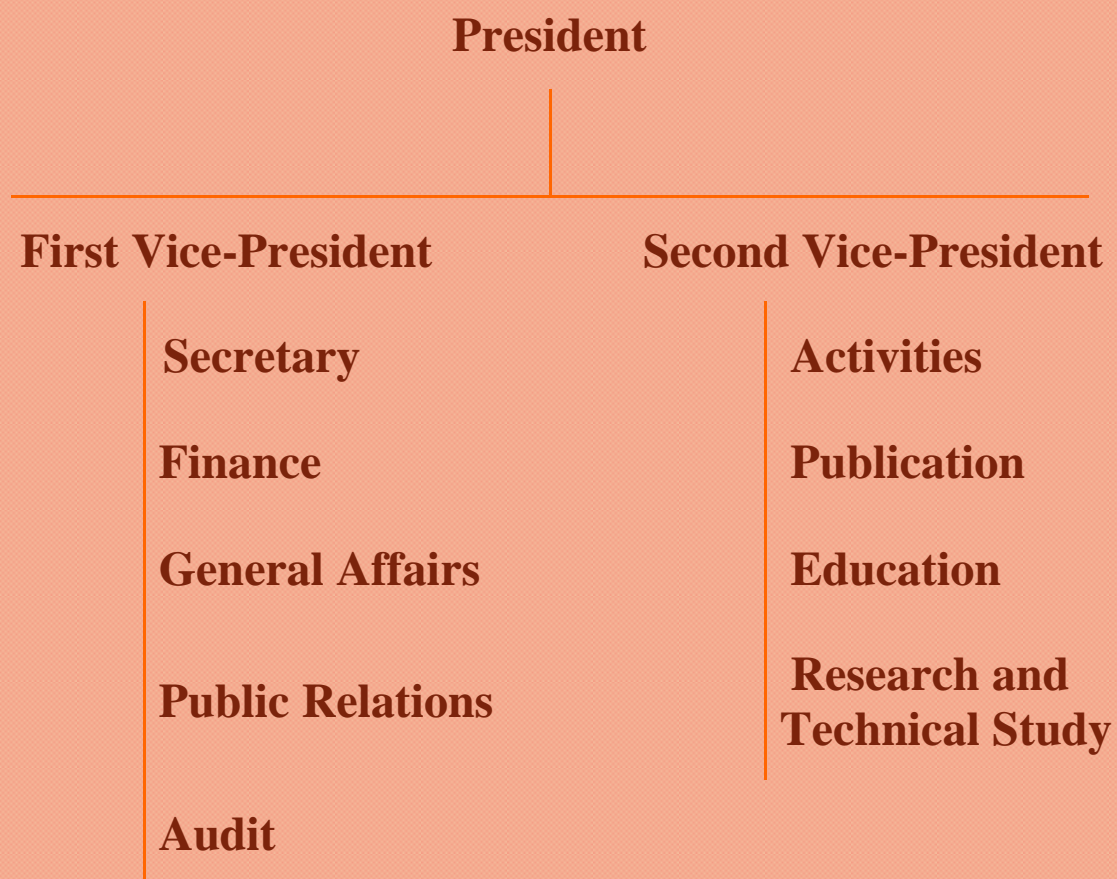
